(Awareness regarding various Scholarship Schemes - Students)

A. Uttar Pradesh Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme (Other Than Intermediate)

The Uttar Pradesh Post-Matric Scholarship scheme provides financial assistance to students from SC, ST, OBC, Minority, and General categories pursuing graduation, postgraduate studies, PhDs, or higher degrees. Eligibility is determined based on income and other criteria.

Post-Matric Other Than Inter: For UG/PG or higher degree students

Eligibility Criteria

- **Category:** SC, ST, OBC, Minority, and General
- **Level of Study:** Graduation, postgraduate studies, PhD, or higher degrees in a recognized institution
- **Income Limits:**
 - OBC, Minority & General Category: Annual household income should not exceed ₹2,00,000.
 - SC/ST Category: Annual household income should not exceed ₹2,50,000.
- **Domicile:** Must be a resident of Uttar Pradesh.
- **Other Requirements:**
 - Must not be receiving benefits from any other state/central scholarship.
 - Must have scored at least 60% marks in 10+2 for UG courses.
 - Must have scored at least 55% marks in graduation for PG/higher degree courses.
 - Must have scored at least 50% marks in all previous years of the course to be eligible for scholarship renewal.
 - Must maintain a minimum of 75% attendance.
 - Must possess the following documents:
 - Valid Income Certificate of parents (Issued by Tehsildar)
 - Valid Caste Certificate of student (Issued by Tehsildar, if applicable)
 - Domicile Certificate of student (Issued by Tehsildar)
 - Student's Aadhaar Card linked to a bank account and mobile number (for OTP verification)
 - Student's Aadhaar-based biometric authentication is required for all eligible students.

Categories of E-Kalyan Jharkhand Scholarships

Students can explore multiple scholarships on the e-Kalyan Jharkhand portal. Below is the list of important scholarships available:

1. Post-Matric (Within State) Scholarship for ST/SC/BC Students
2. Post-Matric (Outside State) Scholarship for ST/SC/BC Students
3. Post-Matric (Within and Outside State) Scholarship for SC Students

Eligibility Criteria

Before applying for a scholarship through the e-Kalyan Jharkhand portal, students must ensure they meet the following eligibility criteria:

- ◆ Must be a domicile or permanent resident of Jharkhand and belong to the Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), or Backward Class (BC) category.
- ◆ Must be enrolled in an Institution/University recognized by the Government of Jharkhand or a competent authority in Jharkhand.
- ◆ Family income should not exceed ₹2.5 Lakh for SC/ST/BC candidates

Required Documents

Applicants must upload scanned copies of essential documents; the required documents include:

1. Recent passport-size photograph
2. Bonafide certificate from the institute, including fee structure of
 - (a) Academic Fee and
 - (b) Hostel fee (If applicable)
3. Valid parent's income certificate
4. Valid student's residence certificate
5. Valid student's category certificate
6. Mark sheet of the previous qualifying examination
7. Bank passbook
8. Student's Adhar Card
9. Parents Adhar card
10. College ID card
11. Hostel ID card (If applicable)
12. Fee Receipts

Categories of NSP Scholarships

The NSP provides scholarships under three major categories:

1. Central Government Schemes

These scholarships are funded by various central government ministries and departments. The key schemes include:

- ◆ Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities
- ◆ Department of Higher Education
- ◆ Ministry of Tribal Affairs
- ◆ Ministry of Minority Affairs
- ◆ Department of School Education & Literacy
- ◆ Ministry of Home Affairs
- ◆ Ministry of Railways (Railway Board)
- ◆ All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)
- ◆ University Grants Commission (UGC) - MHRD
- ◆ North Eastern Council (NEC), DoNER
- ◆ Department of Social Justice & Empowerment
- ◆ Ministry of Labour & Employment
- ◆ Department of Social Justice & Empowerment (Backward Classes)

2. UGC / AICTE Schemes

The University Grants Commission (UGC) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) provide scholarships specifically for higher education students. These schemes include financial support for undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral students pursuing professional and technical courses.

- ◆ PM USP Special Scholarship Scheme For Jammu Kashmir And Ladakh (Merit Based Scheme)
- ◆ AICTE - Pragati Scholarship Scheme For Girl Students (Technical Degree) (Merit Based Scheme)
- ◆ AICTE - Saksham Scholarship Scheme For Specially Abled Student (Technical Degree) (Welfare Based Scheme)
- ◆ UGC-National Scholarship For Post Graduate Studies (Merit Based Scheme)

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for a scholarship through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP), applicants typically must meet certain requirements related to academic performance, family income, and other conditions specified by each scholarship scheme. Common eligibility criteria include:

- A strong academic record, often requiring a minimum percentage in previous examinations
- Family income below a specified threshold (commonly around ₹2.5 lakhs per annum, though this may vary by scheme)
- Enrollment in a full-time, recognized course or program

Specific Eligibility Criteria by Scheme:

- **Merit-Cum-Means Based Scholarship:**
Requires a minimum percentage of marks in the previous qualifying examination and a family income not exceeding ₹2.5 lakhs per annum.
- **Post-Matric Scholarship:**
Eligibility includes meeting a minimum academic performance standard in the previous examination and falling within the prescribed family income limit, which may vary by state.
- **National Scholarship for Post Graduate Studies:**
Open to students pursuing their first postgraduate degree in a full-time program. Applicants must be below 30 years of age.
- **PM-YASASVI Scheme:**
Targeted at OBC, EBC, and DNT students enrolled in full-time programs at recognized institutions, with a family income not exceeding ₹2.5 lakhs per annum.
