❶ CHECK-IN

Report to the **Auditorium, Block-D** with your **UPTAC Seat Allotment Letter** and get **admission form**.

❷ DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

Submit **1 Original set + 2 Self-Attested Photocopy sets** in the checklist sequence.

❸ ERP REGISTRATION

Fill out the ONLINE college ERP registration form at Computer Lab.

❹ FEE BALANCE PAYMENT

Clear the remaining college balance fee after deducting your UPTAC deposit.

❺ OTP VERIFICATION ⚡ (**CRITICAL**)

Share the **Physical Reporting OTP** (sent to your UPTAC-registered mobile) with the admission officer to **confirm your physical reporting** and issue **Temporary Identity Card**.

Frequently Asked Questions (Admission Documents & Eligibility):

Q1: What should I do if my original Migration Certificate is unavailable during admission?

A: You can temporarily submit a color copy of your Migration Certificate downloaded from **DigiLocker**. However, you will need to submit the original hard copy to the college later.

Q2: How can I apply if I haven't received my final-year graduation or diploma marksheets yet?

A: You can submit all marksheets up to your pre-final year/semester, along with a signed eligibility undertaking. The final-year marksheet must be submitted later according to the college's guidelines and timeline.

Q3: Do I need to attest my documents before submitting them?

A: Yes, all document copies submitted for admission must be self-attested by the candidate.

Q4: Can I get admission to B.Tech if I have a compartment or Repeat in Theory (RT) in Class 12?

A: No. Students with a compartment or Repeat in Theory (RT) in any of the subject(s) considered for Class 12-based admission are **not eligible** for B.Tech admission.

Q5: Am I eligible for B.Tech/B.Pharm (Lateral Entry) or MBA/MCA if I have an active backlog in my Diploma or Graduation?

A: No. Students with an active backlog in their Diploma or Graduation program are **not eligible** for B.Tech/B.Pharm (Lateral Entry) or MBA/MCA admissions.

Q6: What happens if I do not meet the minimum percentage or subject criteria for eligibility?

A: If you do not meet the required aggregate percentage or mandatory subject criteria specified for your chosen program, **your admission cannot be processed**.

Frequently Asked Questions (Fee Waiver Quota):

Q1: I have been allotted a seat under the Fee Waiver (FW) quota. How much do I need to pay during reporting?

A: Candidates allotted a seat under the Fee Waiver (FW) quota are required to pay **Rs. 6,000/-** at the time of reporting. This payment covers the **security deposit** and the **application fee**.

Q2: Is the seat confirmation fee refundable after AKTU reimburses the amount?

A: Yes. The seat confirmation fee paid by you during UPTAC-2026 counselling will be refunded once the college receives the reimbursement from AKTU for the enrolled FW quota students in due course of time.

Frequently Asked Questions (Hostel Allocation):

Q1: How are hostel seats allocated at the college?

A: Hostel seats for both boys and girls are limited and are allocated strictly on a **first-come, first-served basis**.

Q2: How and when can I reserve a hostel room?

A: Candidates who wish to avail the hostel facility must complete their admission first and then pay the Hostel Fee (which includes mess charges) using any of the available online or offline payment options.

Frequently Asked Questions (Physical Reporting)

Q1: How long does the physical reporting process take on campus?

A: Physical reporting typically takes 2 to 4 hours to complete from start to finish.

Q2: Can physical reporting take longer on certain days?

A: Yes. During peak admission days or heavy rush hours, the overall process can take up to a half-day (4 to 6 hours). Candidates are advised to plan their visit accordingly.

Q3: How can I speed up the physical reporting process on admission day?

A: You can ensure a faster admission process by keeping the following tips in mind:

- **Arrive Early:** Reach the campus right when the admission desk opens (typically 9:00 AM – 10:00 AM) to beat the peak queues.
- **Organize Your Documents:** Arrange all your original documents and photocopies in the exact sequence specified on the college document checklist.
- **Pre-Attest Photocopies:** Self-attest (sign) all required photocopies beforehand to avoid delays or looking for stationery at the venue.
- **Keep Payment Options Ready:**
 - **If paying by Demand Draft (DD),** ensure it is made out to the correct name and amount beforehand.
 - **For online/digital payments,** verify that your bank account has sufficient balance and that your daily UPI or net banking transfer limits are high enough to cover the total fee.

Q4: Is physical reporting mandatory for candidates who selected the 'Freeze' option?

A: Yes. Physical reporting at the allotted institution is strictly mandatory for all candidates who have chosen or auto-frozen their allotted seat. Online acceptance or fee payment alone does not complete the admission process.

Q5. When and where do I need to report physically?

A: You must physically visit the campus of your allotted institution strictly within the timeframe specified in the official UPTAC-2026 Counselling Schedule and your seat allotment letter.

Q6. What happens if I fail to report physically within the given deadline?

A: If you **fail** to report in person within the official schedule:

- Your allotted seat will be deemed automatically cancelled.
- You will forfeit your claim to the seat, and it will be made available in subsequent counselling/special rounds.

Q4. Will I receive a fee refund if my seat is cancelled due to non-reporting?

A: No. Under no circumstances will a refund be issued if your seat is cancelled due to failure to report physically. The seat acceptance/confirmation fees paid during the counselling process will be forfeited.
