Notice

(Award of Theory Sessional Marks and Attendance Rules : Odd Sem : 2026-27)

All the students are hereby informed that :

1. Award of sessional marks of a theory course, as mentioned in AKTU prescribed Teaching and Evaluation Scheme (available at AKTU.AC.IN ; under SYLLABUS section), is as per following :
 - a. Total Marks of the Subject : 100 (Internal Marks = 30 and External Marks = 70)
 - b. Award of Internal Marks (out of 30) or Theory Sessional Marks is based on :
 - (i) CT Marks (out of 20) – on the basis of average marks obtained in all the conducted tests – which are 3 (CAE-I, CAE-II and PUTs). Means, for a subject - average of marks obtained out of 130 marks (CAE-I = 30; + CAE-II = 30; + PUT = 70)
 - (ii) TA marks (out of 10) – on the basis of attendance (out of 5 marks) and assignment / class-discipline / quizzes / participation in academic activities (of concerned subject, out of 5 marks)
 - c. **Hence, to secure good internal marks (termed as Theory Sessional Marks), each student must appear in all the three conducted tests (in all subjects of CAE-I, CAE-II and PUTs) and must secure good marks in each of the conducted tests.**
2. As per Clause III of AKTU Ordinance :
 - a. Every student is required to attend all the lectures, tutorials, practicals and other prescribed curricular and co-curricular activities. The attendance can be condoned up to 25% on medical grounds or for other genuine reasons beyond the control of students.
 - b. A further relaxation of attendance up to 15% for a student can be given by Head of Institution/college provided that he/she has been absent with prior permission of the Head of the institution/college for the reasons acceptable to him.
3. During ongoing semester, this relaxation (of 15% by HOI) will be based academic performance of the student (i.e. marks obtained in conducted CAE-I, CAE-II and PUTs).
4. Students - having compiled attendance percent less than as prescribed by AKTU in ordinance - will be debarred from appearing in AKTU End Semester Examinations and in CAE-I and CAE-II, as well.
5. Debarred students of B Tech – I, II and III year and MBA/MCA – I year : 2026-27 are permitted to appear in CAE-I and CAE-II. The answer sheets of these debarred students will be evaluated and marks obtained by these debarred students will be considered for :
 - a. Identification of weak and bright student and to take suitable measures to improve their performance
 - b. Award of Sessional Marks – if student maintained Compiled Attendance of 75% or more (till the end of the classes of this semester) in the subject(s). This will be subject-wise.
 - c. Award of Sessional Marks – if student secures compiled attendance of 60% or more (till the end of classes of this semester) in the subject(s) and **average marks obtained in all the conducted tests (CAE-I, CAE-II and PUTs) are 40% or more (in that subject). This will also be the subject-wise.**
