





## **NOTICE**

Students of B Tech – I Sem : 2018-19, having attendance less than AKTU's prescribed limit (refer clause 3 of B Tech Ordinance), can improve their attendance as per following :

Upon completion, 3 attendances (present) will be provided by the subject teacher concerned. Its record will also be maintained by the subject teacher concerned. 

## **NOTICE**

All the students of B. Tech. – I Semester : 2018-19 are required to appear (no debarring of students) in all the III-sessionals tests commencing wef November 26, 2018 with full preparation mandatorily. About 60% marks' questions in III-sessionals will be from Important Questions (e-mailed), Home-assignments and Question Papers of both sessionals (I and II). III-sessionals performance will also help in securing good sessional marks as all the three tests will be considered to award sessional marks (as notified earlier, refer notice of undersigned dated July 31, 2018).

Further, for each presence in III-sessionals, 3 attendances per course's test will be provided, keeping total classes as constant. In case of absence in III-sessionals, 5 marks per absence may be deducted (e.g. if student remains absent in 3 courses' III-Sessional Tests, 15 marks may be deducted).

Moreover, III-sessionals will be from full syllabus of the course concerned and will be conducted for three theory courses only (Maths-I, Physics / Chemistry and Electrical Engg / Programming for Problem Solving), tentatively on Nov 26, 28, 30, 2018. The detailed schedule will be provided by examination cell.
