Mr. Saurabh Jain (Head: 'Paytm-Build for India', Founder: Fun2Do labs, Mentor- Digital Business Delhi Press), graced the session which was organised to enlighten students regarding prevailing industry job requirements and opportunities available for open source contributors.

Having such experienced and incredibly talented technical leader to share his first hand experiences in the industry proved no short of blessing for the students. The event was a relaxed form of interaction and discussion between Mr. Subham Kumar and Mr. Saurabh Jain, in the presence of other technically curious students. While answering questions raised by the students, Mr. Saurabh Jain suggested that apart from the learning regular academic subjects, a student should strive to get accustomed to using platforms like Arduino, Swift, Kotlin etc. He revealed that the secret to getting a better job is to start working on self-made projects as early as one can. According to him, reading books apart from regular textbooks is essential for widening a student's perspective of the industry, to start, he can read "Bag of Napkins" or "Lean Startup" and other similar books.

250 students attended the session and all of them agreed that it was very informative and almost every query was answered appropriately and it helped them in gaining insights into the technical industry and the upcoming technologies that may take over the market.
